2016 AKDHA Reunion Kilian/Killian/Killion DNA Project Report

The DNA Project began in 2002 to connect Killians with a broken lineage back to Andreas. The project has been successful in linking descendants of Andreas to the family, but not to the family tree. Such proof is Daniel born 1790. We know Daniel Born 1790 is a descendant of Andreas. We know that the most probable son to which he descends is Leonard, but we don't know which of Leonard's son could be Daniel's father.

The DNA Project also helped William R. McCreight confirm Andreas descended from Sebastian Killian born before 1560 in Germany.

The DNA Project has also grouped many men with the Killian (any way you spell it) into their own groups. These men are not related to Andreas due to a father to son DNA lineage.
